Major Activities planned and implemented in the year

Dry ration only if they are very very marginal and in need of such support.

From January 2020 to June 2020, 55 families of 7 villages have been identified under Covid-19 as well as migrant families as well as village daily labor under the Clad Project by the Gratitude Committee. 15-day dry ration was distributed to eligible families, which included daily essential ingredients like flour, pulse, rice, salt, turmeric, 2 chilly, coriander, sugar, soap, oil, in which these families could get at least 15 to 20 days of food at their village home. Due to a disaster like Covid-19 living with family at the time of fatal illness, it was possible to send two times and stay safe.

This work brought relief to the people who were given ration and expressed gratitude to the IGSSS as well as the Aabhar Mahila Samiti. In this work, mainly with the PTA members constituted in village Sarpanch village with us, the employees associated with the project remained with them and this work was done.

Vegetable kit for kitchen garden.

As we all know that not only in our country, the whole world is suffering from Covid-19, who has left no one, whether poor or rich, has taken thousands of people in his grip, and it has been continuously running. In such a situation, thousands of families have come to their homes in the metropolis that have affected the lives of these families very much today, they do not have work, there is no employment, there is no money, so many efforts are being made at every stage. In which people will be able to get food for two days only in the village, efforts have also been made from the government level, in which these families are being provided ration through PDS, but they will use dry ration for them and other items along with the service is required.

Due to the efforts of IGSSS, about 300 families in 15 villages who are migrants who do not have any resources, have little agriculture or have some vacant places around the house, in which they can do kitchen garden, by marking such women or men who have made kitchen gardens. In which these families will get fresh service along with the food of two speakers, as well as financial income, which will be able to meet the daily needs of these families to some extent and provide nutritious food of two times, so that these families will stay for a long time. So they will be able to stay safe in a disaster like Covid-19.

A total of 305 families of 140 women 165 men of 10 village were added by the institutions, in which kitchen garden was made by planting seeds and pods of Loni / Kadu / Taroi / Barbati / Chilli / Began / Mathe / Spinach / Tomato / Paalak etc... In a village which Rampur / Dhawari / Tikri Chohani / Wadi Chohani / Vaniyani / Kahari / Khuderi is included.

Cash for work support

As we all know that India along with the whole world is also suffering from the disaster of Covid-19 and today the figure of death rate is increasing continuously day by day which is affected most of workers who have continued unemployment since January 2020. Whether it is from any caste community.

People have come back to their home from Big cities to village. If we talk about Chhatarpur district, then about 76,000 families have left their work and have come back, they have no money for provide food their children at least two time in a day. There is need for labor in such a situation that they should be given money to get employment, cash should be paid per day so that at the time of this disaster, the family can give two meals a day.

During the work, it was seen that most people do not have a job card, no bank account, in such a situation, they are not getting the benefit of their government schemes, which has increased their concern further, in such a way, with the help of IGSSS Cash for work support work plan was prepared and which was linked to the need work of the people, in which government work was also done in which people would get work and cash could also be received so that 6 villages were identified and the plan was made. Made construction, harmonization, mining, farm ponds, other ground work were done in which about 45 people were given work, in which 22 women 23 men were given 3 to 5 days of work, in which income of Rs 1500 to 2500 per person was given. The work was done on the same 9 acres of land, from which the work of putting mud along with med bandhan, field pond or labeling was done.

Seeds / grain bank

Under the Clade Project, work is being done in 15 villages of Block, Barikgarh district Chhatarpur in which thousands of people have come back from the metros, who today have neither income nor employment.

It is a farming land that makes the farmer want to save his life by farming because he knows that there will be no quick relief from this disaster and he has to decide his employment by staying in his village.

Seed bank set up by the institution, which can be managed only by farming, through the seed bank, 300 farmers of 15 villages were given seed through seed bank, in which 2 kg / 500 seeds per farmer were distributed in which urd, munga, tili are included.

By this farmer will be able to live in the village and do other employment along with farming, in which the family will be able to get nutritious food for two times and will be protected from the deadly disaster like Covid-19, as well as their livelihood will be fixed which will change their life. And farming will also get big.

Pond Cleaning-

Under Covid-19, the check dam was built by the government in the village Dhawari, which is quite poor and in poor condition, which does not have a pier, it is lying on some walls with deep check dam, a public well which have to be cleaned. The need of the village meeting and panchayat determined that the people of the village are in need of immediate work according to the present situation and if work is done at the check dam, the laborer will get employment soon as well as year-round. As soon as the water is stored in the dam, the animals will be able to get water for at least 6 months along with the village residents, so that 50 percent of the family will get the benefit of the village. Dam construction work was done with the consent of all, in which a 5 foot deep check dam and a 3 meter ghat construction was done with a 9 foot wall imprint work was done with the construction of ghat and wall repairing, in which about 23 people of village were given 5 days of work, which earned about 1500. rupees per person.

Sarpanch said that more work is needed in this check dam, whatever may be done with the support of the organization or whatever resource has been done now.

The amount received by this work worked for some relief in his life and he will gain the self-confidence of the people, who thanked the IGSSS and the Foundation for expressing their gratitude.

Non Budgeted Activities in the year contributing to achievements (max 1000 words):

Under Covid-19, an attempt was made to make the community aware in the area of work, the people were asked to apply masks on leaving the house with washing hands and if really need than only get out from house and told that the people come back from the metros and give their information on the phone number issued by the Panchayat Secretary or the administration. If someone has a cold, fever or sore throat, immediately go to doctor and take proper checkup and follow the government rules, in this way awareness work was done in the 10 villages. Cooperation with the Panchayat through the committees formed in the village, cooperation in distribution of ration essentials.

Analysis and Understanding of the achievements and trends of the project based on the MIS (max 1000 words):

If you talk about MIS, people have connected with this process and are aware that today people of the community are satisfied with the information related to weather change or in which weather to cultivate which water will be used or why it is necessary to cultivate misc. Have already got the same information on the website from time to time, the farmer is getting information on his mobile, there is all such information which is being found at the farmer on their mobile, so there has been a lot of change in the farmer.

People from the same community have to take up work like the farm pond, land, land leveling, warder, plantation, kitchen garden, etc. Today, farmers are calling our people and asking for information which shows a change that our farmers are alert and change their way of farming.

After the quarter's activities we have seen the following results;

- Mix cropping started by 300 farmers.
- Med Bandhan Work 75 acres.
- Kitchen gardens were started by the 305 families.
- Ground leveling 20 acres.
- 11 Khet Tallab were prepared by the farmers.
- Covid-19 Relief Program 300 family.
- Covid-19 Awareness Program.
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Unexpected Outcomes if any those not planned but resulted as a positive or negative outcome (max 1000 words):

Today farmers are cultivating both Ravi and Khari crops in Monsoons, as well as water conservation field, pond along with kitchen garden are deciding to improve their livelihood and Gram Panchayat, have prepared an action plan for the need of the people. Because of Covid -19, lots of people lost their employment.

Challenges faced in implementation and how these challenges have been addressed (max 1000 words):

Severe drought, migration and poor implementation of government schemes were the main challenges.

We tried to address drought through Water budgeting.

- Tried to link families with MNREGA and other schemes and support the families through our programs to face the migration issue.
- Advocacy done for the better implementation of government schemes to address the poor implementation of government schemes.
- To make people aware of disaster like Covid -19 and motivate them to use Masks

To ensure employment and livelihood of families who have come from metros due to Covid-19

CBO members were very actively participated in all activities.

Many have adopted the learning of the trainings and approached to the government department.

CBO members negotiated with the gram panchayat for MNREGA implementation

People are changing due to the work being done by the organization, whether it is water conservation work from the ground, mixed farming, like kitchen garden med bhandan has changed lives in people and today other villagers of the community are also joining this process. Due to

which the farmer is being able to deal with the happiness and is self-sufficient Key Challenges faced in implementation and how these challenges have been addressed.

CASE-STUDIES:

मेरा नाम रेखा पाल- उम्र 36 वर्ष मैं गाँव धवारी ब्लाक वारीगढ जिला छतरपुर की निवासी हूँ जैसा कि मैं व मेरा परिवार जिसके दो बच्चे मेरे पति के पास कृषि भूमि नहीं है, मैं पिछले 3 वर्ष से दिल्ली में दैनिक मजदूरी का कार्य करती हूँ। मैंने ठेकेदार के



माध्यम से अलग अलग स्थानों काम कर के प्रति दिन के हिसाब से 300 से 400 रुपये प्रति दिन मिल जाता था जिसमें महिने में 10000 से 12 हजार रुपये से हमको मिल जाता था वहीं मेरे पति भी काम करते थे उनको भी प्रति दिन 400 से 500 रुपये मिलते थे तो सब मिल कर अच्छा कमा लेते थे और कुछ बचत हो जाती थी जिसमें घर परिवार के लोगों की ग्राम में मदद हो जाती थी ।

सब कुछ ठीक से चल रहा था हम सब मिल कर कार्य करते थे और शाम को दो वक्त की रोटी शुक्ल के साथ चल रही थी पर अचानक मालूम हुआ की अभी काम बंद कर दिया है हम लोगों ने

सोचा चलो एक दो दिन में काम चालू हो जायेगा और सब ठीक होगा जैसा पहले से सब कुछ ठीक था पर 20 मार्च 2020 का हमने भारत में और दुनिया में भर में फैली महामारी कोरोना के बारे में सुना । की यह एक भयानक बीमारी है इसका कोई इलाज नहीं है एक दुसरे के पास आने या हाथों के एक दुसरे के छुने या अन्य तरह से एक से अनेक में फैल रही है तो ठेकेदार ने निर्माण किया की अब काम बिल्कुल से बंद करना पड़ेगा क्योंकि अब पुरा भारत बंद हो रहा है और शहरों में कोरोना के मरीज बढ़ रहे हैं अब कोई काम भी नहीं करवाना चाहता है ऐसे में एक ही चारा बचता है कि काम बंद कर दिया जाये ।

हम लोग सोच रहे थे कि ऐसे ही होगा एक दो दिन में काम कहीं न कहीं तो चालू होगा पर ऐसा नहीं हुआ और जो कुछ कमाया था वह भी वहाँ खर्च हो रहा था अधिकशास लोग वापिस जा रहे थे धीरे धीरे आने जाने के साधन भी कम हो रहे थे ऐसी चर्चा सुनाई दे रही थी । हम लोगों ने विचार किया और हमने वापिस अपने घर आने की व्यवस्था की क्योंकि अब पैसा भी नहीं था और काम भी नहीं / वहीं रहने का ठिकाना भी अब नहीं बन पा रहा था क्योंकि ठेकेदार ने कह दिया था कि अब काम नहीं होगा आप लोग अपनी अपनी व्यवस्था करो । साईड से जना पड़ेगा ऐसे में एक ही विचार था कि अब कोई उपाय नहीं है अभी जाने का अवसर है तो क्यों न घर चले जो होगा वहीं होगा देखा जायेगा वस क्या था व्यवस्था की और घर ग़सस्ती का सामान उठा कर निकल आये पहले रेल व बस का सफर कर के छतरपुर आये ही थे कि शासन के लोगों ने होम कोरनाटाईम में कर दिया जिसमें जो कुछ बचा था वह भी खत्म हो गया और हालात बिगड़ दिख रहे थे पता नहीं क्यों होगा क्योंकि अभी तो यहाँ पर भी काम नहीं है लोग घर से नहीं निकल पा रहे ऐसे में परिवार की चिन्ता से ग़स्त के छ समझ नहीं आ रहा था हमने आगनवाड़ी दीदी व हमारे ग्राम में काम करे मिश्रा जी से बात की तो पता चला कि कोई एक संस्था है जो बाहर से आये हुये श्रमिकों के वारे में जानकारी जमा कर रही है ।

संस्था आभार महिला समिति जो हमारे यहाँ पर पहले से ही काम कर रही थी और आगनवाड़ी में सभी जानते थे उन्होंने बताया कि श्रमिकों के लिए कुछ सर्वे संस्था द्वारा किया जा रहा है हो सकता है कि कुछ मंदद श्रमिकों की हो जाये तो मेने भी अपना नाम दर्ज कराने का कहा और उन सब लोगों ने आशा की एक किरण दिखाई और मेरा नाम जुड़ा दिया । तीन से चार दिन बाद जानकारी मिली की संस्था कुछ सुखा राशन वितरण करने आ रही है जिसमें मुझे भी कुपन दिया और बुलाया बड़ी सी बोरी

की क्रीट दी गई जिसमे 15 दिन का पुरा राशन था जिसमे आटा चावल दाल सबजी तेल साबून मास्क नमक शक्कर चाय धनिया मिर्च हल्दी आदि के अलावा अन्य वस्तुएं शामिल थी बहुत ही खुशी मिली जब दीदी के लोगो ने घर आ राशन दिया ।

मे मेरा परिवार संस्था के साथ उन सब की शुक्रगुजार हूँ जिन्होने मेरे वारे मे सोचा और मेरी मदद की । आप सब का बहुत बहुत धन्यवाद
